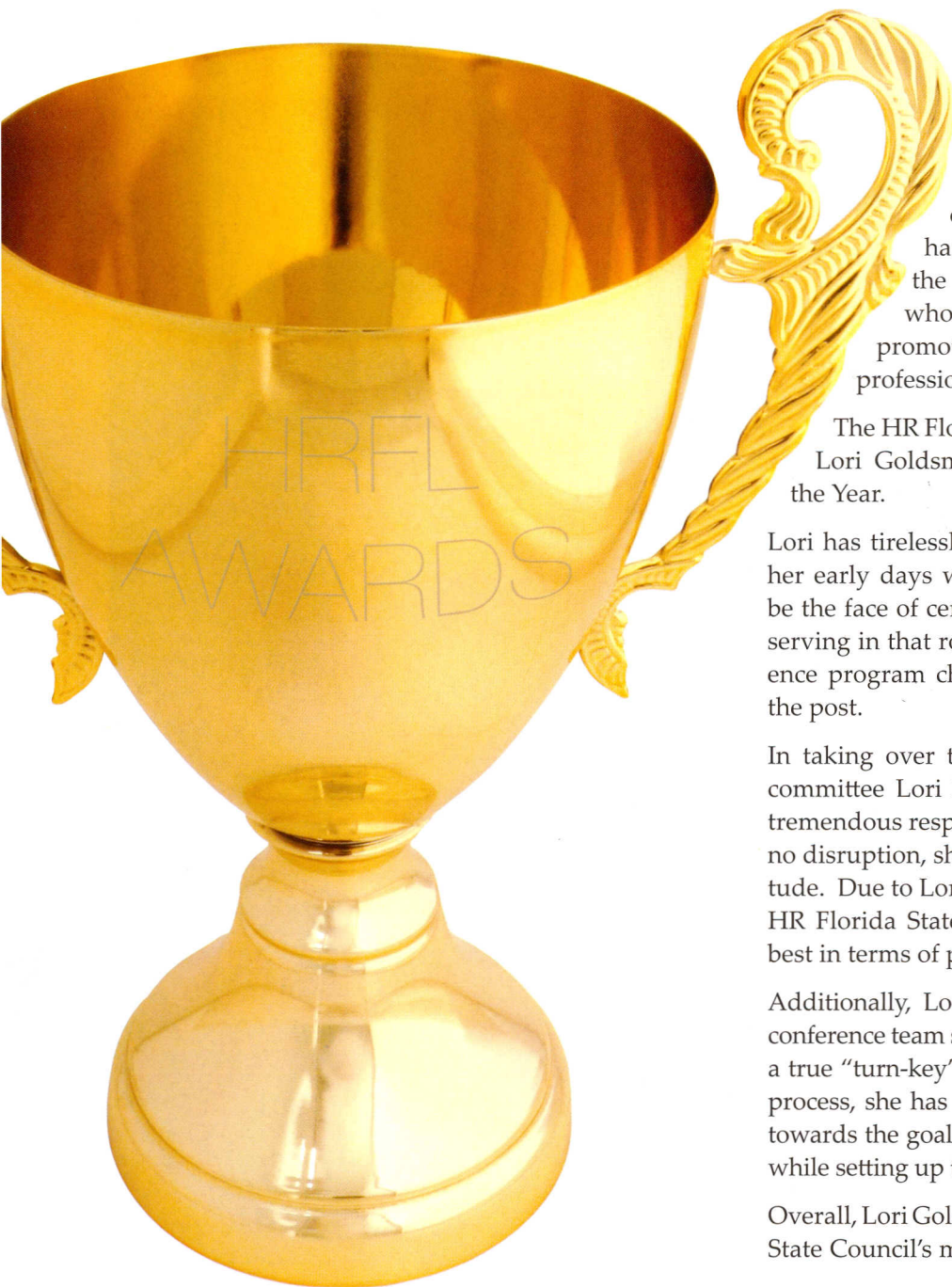


HR Florida Awards
